SCHOLARSHIPS – NEW FOR 2011

The International President's Award scholarship will be automatically awarded (the number of awards will vary each year depending on the number of eligible applicants) to each U of R international undergraduate student who meets the following criteria:

- Entrance scholarship average of 80% to 89% (\$500 award)
- Entrance scholarship average of 90% or higher (\$1000 award)
- Must be an international student on a Study Permit and be subject to international student differential tuition and fees
- Fully accepted into any undergraduate degree program at the University of Regina
